Ted Anagnoson will present a single session analyzing the results of the November election a little more than a week after election day. He will use surveys, graphs, maps, charts, and other data to analyze who won, who lost, and who will be back next time. The major emphasis will be on the national scene, but he will cover the state and local election of 2022 as well. We will try to get some historical context on this momentous year's results. We will use political scientists' analyses from both before and after the election, as well as analyses



and graphs from the New York Times and Washington Post, among others. The emphasis is on understanding what happened and why.

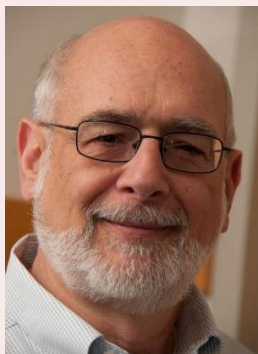
