“Trafficking in persons,” “human trafficking,” and “modern slavery” are umbrella terms — often used interchangeably — to refer to a crime in which traffickers exploit and profit at the expense of adults or children by compelling them to perform labor or engage in commercial sex.

Using domestic and international cases to illustrate her extensive experience in working with trafficked persons, Florrie Burke will share her stories of more than 25 years as consultant, expert witness, member and chair of many national and international organizations fighting to eliminate the tragedy of human trafficking here in the USA and around the world.



Florrie Burke is a consultant on human trafficking and modern-day slavery to both governmental and non-governmental agencies. She is a leading expert on the victim-centered approach in human trafficking cases and collaborative efforts of criminal justice actors and victim care providers. She is a founding member of the Freedom Network USA and has been on training faculties of the UNODC, the Department of State, and the Institute for Intergovernmental Research.
