We all know that Santa Barbara is a beautiful city ... and we all know that the Santa Barbara Courthouse is a unique and dramatic expression of the character of our city. When completed in 1929, the Courthouse became the symbol of a new identity for the city of Santa Barbara. It took a history of ingenuity and design to invent our city's famous image.

During this two-day VISTAS seminar, we'll look at how the design of the city and the design of the Courthouse influenced each other to create the special place we know today. In Session 1, we'll review key events and people who shaped the Spanish image of Santa Barbara and its historic colonial and architectural relationships to Spain. Then we'll explore what inspired the community leaders of Santa Barbara to decide that the Courthouse should be designed in the architectural style of southern Spain. In Session 2, we'll focus on the skills of two innovative architects whose talents were unexpectedly brought together for the Courthouse, and how the building got its "National Historic Landmark" form. Finally, we'll look at how our city became a pioneer for urban design in America.
