Ever wonder why humans always wanted to fly, despite being ill-equipped for it? Was it envy of birds? Certainly, early human efforts to do so relied on studying birds and trying to fly as they do; these resulted in outcomes sometimes comedic and all too often injurious or fatal. Now, however, more people than ever board airplanes. In these two sessions, we will discuss the following subjects: (i) a brief history of aviation, (ii) the forces acting on an airplane during flight, (iii) airplane devices and instruments employed to maintain safety, (iv) ground-based services, including radar surveillance, available to aircraft on the ground and in flight, and (v) mistakes made by pilots and air traffic controllers that contribute to accidents. Lastly, we will consider the role of the FAA in maintaining safety for airplanes during ground and flight operations.
