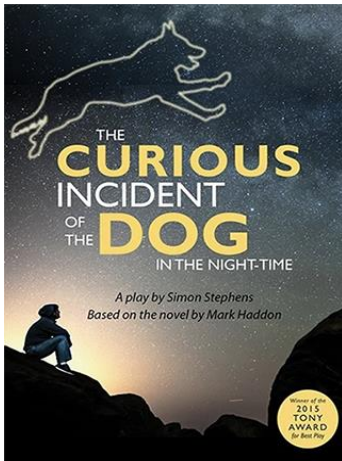

The story is told from the perspective of Christopher, a 15-year-old boy who describes himself as a “mathematician with some behavioral difficulties” living in England. He has never ventured alone beyond the end of his road, he detests being touched, and he distrusts strangers. When Christopher discovers the dead body of his neighbor’s dog and finds himself under suspicion, he is determined to find out what happened. He overcomes fears and difficulties, setting off on a perilous adventure to uncover the mystery behind the murdered dog and the truth of his own unique life story.
