

This seminar will present three topics from African-American musical life in the early 20th century. The first class will concern the development of the spiritual from the Fisk Jubilee Singers to concert presentations by singers like Roland Hayes, Paul Robeson, and Marian Anderson, and will discuss the shifting meaning of the spirituals for the intellectuals of the Harlem Renaissance.

The second class will focus on the band leaders James Reese Europe and Fletcher Henderson in order to illustrate the intersection between the business practices and musical products in New York in the 1910s and 1920s.

The third session will center on the early career of Louis Armstrong, the emergence of the soloist in early jazz, and the construction of a distinctive "New Orleans style."
