Join your VISTAS friends as we once again attend an Opera Santa Barbara production, the second of their season.

Based on a 1994 Italian movie of the same title, the opera *Il Postino* was written and composed by the Mexican composer, writer, and professor Daniel Catán (1949–2011). The opera's premiere took place in 2010 at the Los Angeles Opera.

Il Postino (The Postman) tells a bittersweet tale of love, exile, political conflict ... and metaphors. As the opera begins, the great Chilean poet Pablo Neruda has been forced into political exile on a small Italian island He receives so much fan mail that a young local man, Mario, is assigned the task of delivering it each day by bicycle. Noticing that most of the letters are from women, Mario realizes that poetry might be the key to winning the heart of the woman he loves, the local barmaid Beatrice, and he begs Neruda to teach him how to become a poet himself.
